

**Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973**

Pursuant to Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and complementary federal and state legislation and implementing regulations regarding the education of handicapped persons, Community High School District 99 shall not discriminate against individuals with disabilities regarding access to all educational programs and activities which it operates. Community High School District 99 provides appropriate educational programs for all persons between the ages of three (3) and twenty-one (21) years who have exceptional needs and who reside within the boundaries of the school district. All regulations pertaining to parent/student due process rights under the Section 504 will be followed and provided in writing. This includes the right of the parent/student to request a formal review or impartial hearing pertaining to 504 eligibility, assessment, and/or accommodations.

Inquiries concerning the application of the provisions of Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 to Community High School District 99 are referred to a Section 504 coordinator appointed by the Board of Education.
