

**Community High School District 99 North
Student Parking Information/application 2009-2010**

Information

District 99 provides bus transportation for all students who meet the state guidelines. Limited automobile parking for students is available. There is increasing competition for a fixed number of parking spaces. *Parking is a privilege. Parking permits cannot be guaranteed.* Senior students who have a particular need to drive may complete an application for a parking permit. The cost for a parking permit is \$75.00 per semester.

Priority

The priority order for issuing parking permits is as follows:

- Students eligible for busing and enrolled in the North H.S. Work Experience Program, Early Bird Class, Intro to Teaching Program or the Cosmetology Program per semester.
- Senior lottery (contingent on space remaining).
 - Applications for the senior lottery are due in the student activities office by 4:00 p.m. **Thursday, August 20, 2009**. The lottery will fill remaining spaces for both first and second semesters.
- Special medical situations (by special request).

Application Process

An application must be submitted for a student-parking permit. Applications can be obtained on Fee Payment Day or from the Student Activities Office. Before receiving your parking tag you will need ***your drivers' license, insurance card and payment of \$75.00.*** Checks can be made out to Community School District 99 North or cash. It is the student driver's responsibility to obtain a temporary permit from the student activities office if he/she forgets to display their regular permit. Village tickets will be issued to cars that do not have or do not properly display the permit. Village tickets are non-negotiable. Student Parking Regulations and Permission

Regulations

1. Cars must have a valid parking permit in order to park in the Student Parking Lot. Unauthorized cars parked in the parking lot will receive a citation and/or be towed at the owner's/driver's expense.
2. Parking stickers will be issued each semester. At the end of the 1st semester, students will need to turn in their 1st semester sticker. At that time, their status will be reviewed as to their eligibility for a 2nd semester sticker. Permits issued through the senior lottery are only valid for **one semester**.
3. The parking fee is \$75.00 per semester. If the permit is lost, stolen, or revoked for any reason, it will not be replaced and the fee will not be refunded.
4. The parking permit must be displayed and visible from the moment the vehicle arrives on campus. The tag must hang from the rear view mirror.
5. A parking permit will be revoked for the following behavior(s), which involve the driver and/or passengers in the vehicle:
 - Inappropriate conduct such as reckless driving, loitering in the parking lot, or other serious offenses related to the use of the vehicle.
 - Use or possession of drugs, alcohol, or tobacco in or around the vehicle while on school property.
6. Students wishing to go to their car during the school day must have written permission from the Dean's Office. Students who leave the building (or allow a fellow student) to go to their car without permission from their Dean may be subject to revocation of the permit with no refund.
7. Students must heed "**NO PARKING AREAS**". These are posted or marked and include the faculty areas and visitors parking.
