2. Within College Research Section, click on Supermatch College Search

  - Location, majors, my scores, tuition and fees, school type, getting in (within each, choose the "level" of importance)

  - Click on a school to get more specific information about that college
  - Click "Graph" which is one way to see a scattergram.
