Dear DGN Parents & Guardians,

Over the next few weeks, your son or daughter will be meeting with their counselor to select courses for the 2017-2018 school year. As parents/guardians, we ask that you partner with us in this process by talking with your son and daughter about their course selections. You can find descriptions for all DGN courses in the 2017-2018 Registration Guide located on this webpage.

Current DGN students will also receive a course selection worksheet on January 26, 2017 during Advisement Day. Members of the Class of 2021 (current 8th grade students) received a course selection worksheet in the packet mailed to their home in late December. We ask that students complete the worksheet, in consultation with you, and bring it to their registration appointment. Blank copies of these worksheets, which are class specific (Class of 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021) can be found on this webpage.

Beginning January 23, 2017, parents of students in the Class of 2018, 2019 and 2020 are able to view their student's current course requests in the Home Access Center (HAC). Current course selections will be found at the bottom of the schedule screen (within the HAC). Please note that course requests are only recommendations until after the student's registration appointment with his or her counselor. Students, who have not yet met with their counselor, will have "Z000: Has No Schedule" as one of their course recommendations; this code will be deleted once the student has attended his/her registration appointment. . Students in the Class of 2021 and their parents will receive course recommendations during our Open House on Thursday, February 9, 2017. Once courses have been selected, changes will **only** be made for the following reasons: enrollment process error, failure in a prerequisite course, successful completion of summer school course or scheduling conflicts.
