- Implementing the schedule this year was a necessary first step in transforming how students take accountability for their learning.

## **Instructional Misconceptions**

- Perceived vs. Actual "Loss of Minutes" minutes per week <u>does not</u> translate into better academic performance.
  - Grades are similar this year to last year
- D99's grading philosophy of minimum grading
  - Research shows students put more effort into their learning, earn higher test scores on state exams and graduate at higher levels

## Recommended Handbook Policy for Cell Phones


- To decrease distractions, personal electronic devices (cell phones, earbuds, etc.) must be silenced and students are not to use them in classroom settings unless given explicit permission from their teacher.
- Student devices are not permitted to be used in the following areas where there is the expectation of privacy: Washroom, Locker Rooms, Nurse's Office.
- Changes to the Student Handbook will be recommended to the Board of Education to be approved as policy this summer.



#### **Updates from April Meetings**

- Ten teachers were granted tenure.
- We held a required public hearing to allow for Driver Education to substitute for one semester of Physical Education
- Summer facility projects at DGS include Fine Arts flooring and new asphalt for the student parking lot
- 3rd Quarter financial report was shared; expenses and revenue are in line with expectations
- The district's assessed valuation is strong and growing. The total tax rate for 2022 is 1.9215, an increase in \$86,000 in new revenue; D99 remains the second lowest tax rate among high school districts in DuPage
