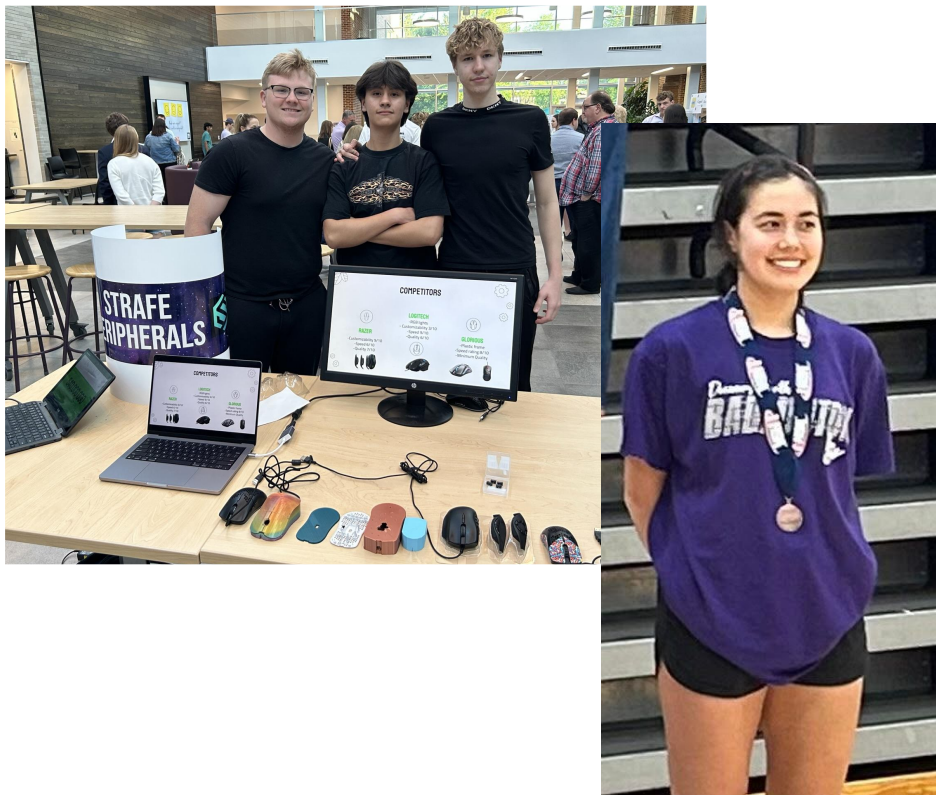

Recommended Handbook Policy for Cell Phones
