

Class of 2026 Ready Course Rotation

This is the course rotation schedule for students in the Ready Program. This sequence ensures that all graduation requirements are met in four years, so electives are only offered “in program” once every four years. These are guidelines and all class placement decisions are made with stakeholder input at the Annual Review IEP meeting. Varying from this sequence in one class may result in needing to vary from the sequence in other classes.

All courses are offered at three levels: Topics, Elements, and Concepts. Decisions regarding placement depends on student needs and is determined at the Annual Review. Courses are skill based and multi-grade level. Curricula is individualized to the specific needs of the students in each class.
