

Class of 2026 Supportive Course Rotation

This is the course rotation schedule for students in the Supportive Program. This sequence ensures that all graduation requirements are met in four years, so electives are only offered “in program” once every four years. Drivers’ Education needs to be taken outside of the program. These are guidelines and all class placement decisions are made with stakeholder input at the Annual Review IEP meeting. Varying from this sequence in one class may result in needing to vary from the sequence in other classes.

Additionally, students may use their lunch period on “block” days to take credit recovery classes.
