2024 ADVANCED PLACEMENT EXAMINATIONS

Through college-level AP courses, you enter a universe of knowledge that might otherwise remain unexplored in high school; through AP Exams, you have the opportunity to earn credit or advanced standing at many of the nation's colleges and universities. Approximately 77% of AP examinations taken by DGN students last year earned grades of 3 or higher. These results brought students opportunities for advanced work and the possibility of savings in college costs.

To determine whether or not you should take an examination, do the following now:

- 1. Consult with your teacher.
- 2. Find out about AP credit or advance standing policies at the college/university of your choice by checking the website or by calling the admissions office.

The 2024 AP examinations will be given Monday, May 6, 2024, through Friday, May 17, 2024. You are not considered absent from class during the time you are taking these exams. The schedule for this year is as follows:

REGISTRATION:

For the 2024 AP exam registration, all Downers Grove North High School students will be registering online. This registration will take a few minutes and can be completed from any computer with internet access.

- Online exam registration will begin on Monday, September 11, for yearlong and Fall semester courses and will end on Monday, November 6. Spring semester courses have until March 8.
- Late registration will begin on Monday, October 30, and will end on Monday, November 6. All late registrations from October 30 to November 6 will incur a \$10.00 late fee per exam. Monday, November 6th is *DGNs final fall/full year deadline*.
- Any registrations after November 15, College Board will incur a \$40 late fee per exam for yearlong and Fall semester courses.
- Any Spring registrations from March 2-8 will incur a \$10 late fee.

In order to register, students should click on the link provided on the North High website or go to: www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/141630 to register. To complete registration students/parents must answer all of the required questions. Registration is not complete until students/parents have completed the registration process with Total Registration AND CollegeBoard. Once you have completed the process with Total Registration you must then sign into your CollegeBoard account and go to "My AP" then use the join code that was provided by your AP Teacher or on your Total Registration Receipt. If you do not have your join code, please contact Tracy Nehls at (630)795-8415. Within the registration process with CollegeBoard you will be asked what your high school is. Please use the school code (141-630) to search for your high school to ensure you are entering the proper high school. Please make sure you are using a PERSONAL email address in your CollegeBoard profile, not your school email address. If you already have a CollegeBoard account and are using your District 99 email address please go into your CollegeBoard profile and change it. DGN does not have access to Total Registration or CollegeBoard logins. If you are having trouble accessing either, please contact Total Registration at (800) 974-2187 or CollegeBoard at (888) 225-5427.

FEES:

- September 11 October 29: \$102 per examination (This fee includes a \$4.00 administrative fee.)
- October 30 November 6: \$102 per examination <u>plus \$10.00</u> (\$4.00 administrative fee plus \$10.00 late)
- After November 15: \$102 per examination <u>plus \$40.00 per exam (</u>\$4.00 administrative fee plus \$40.00 per exam late fee)
- March 2-8 (Spring Semester): \$102 per examination <u>plus \$10.00</u> (\$4.00 administrative fee plus \$10.00 late fee)

REGISTRATIONS CANNOT BE TAKEN AFTER MARCH 8TH

REFUND POLICY

- Students who can cancel an exam before November 15th are entitled to a full refund.
- Students who cancel an exam after November 15th may receive a partial (-\$40 per exam).
- After Monday, May 1, there are no refunds.
