Dear Parent or Guardian,

**The State of Illinois has revised the requirement for the Meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV4) of students entering the 12<sup>th</sup> grade. Two doses of the Meningococcal vaccination are required for entry into 12<sup>th</sup> grade.** The first dose shall have been received on or after the 11th birthday, and the second dose shall have been received on or after the 16th birthday, and at least 8 weeks after the first dose. If the first dose of the Meningococcal vaccine is administered on or after the 16th birthday, then only one dose is required for entry into 12th grade.

**Our records indicate your child has not received a Meningococcal vaccination (MCV4) on or after the age of 16.**

**Documentation of the Meningococcal vaccination, signed and dated by a healthcare provider, must be provided to the nurse's office of Downers Grove South High School by June 1, 2024.**

**Senior students will not receive a schedule in August until the required vaccination information has been submitted to Health Services. Students will also be excluded from attending class on the first day of school, and every day thereafter, until documentation of the required vaccine has been received by Health Services.**

**Please schedule an appointment immediately with your child's healthcare provider to receive this vaccine.** Depending on your insurance, you may also be able to receive the vaccine through the DuPage County Health Department. Appointments may be scheduled at the DuPage County Health Department by calling 630-682-7400.
