

Resource Rooms/Library

All resource rooms and the Library are provided as a service to students. Students are expected to demonstrate respect for teachers/peers and to follow guidelines. If a student wishes to go to the Library or a resource center during a lunch resource or study hall period, he/she should report directly to the Library or resource center before the tardy bell. Some rooms require a signed pass by a teacher.

Career & Technical Education Department CTE Resource	The CTE Resource Center is open to students currently enrolled in a CTE course. The center is staffed by 1 CTE teacher. Computer software for all CTE courses, as well as sewing machines for fashion students, are available. In addition, the center is used for test makeup and project assistance. English Computer Lab	The English Computer Lab is accessible for students to work on assignments for their English classes including essays, presentations, online research, etc. The Lab also provides a variety of writing software to help students improve their scores on standardized tests such as the ACT. A pass from an English teacher is required for admission during the school day. Availability during the school day depends on classroom use.	B323A	7:30-4:00
English Literacy Center	Students can visit the Literacy Center for assistance from peer tutors and/or teachers on reading strategies and all aspects of the writing process: planning, drafting, revising, and publishing. Students may reserve a tutoring session through their English teacher or by stopping in B323B to schedule. Drop-ins are welcome, depending on availability.	B323B	Periods 4, 5, 6 & 8
Library	Students may use the Library on a first come first serve basis during periods that they have study hall, resource or lunch. Students may also use the Library before or after school. (7 – 4:30) Student IDs are required at all times except before school. Entry during the lunch periods (4, 5 & 6) is according to last name. (Monday & Thursday - A through L, Tuesday & Friday - M through Z, Wednesday - all students) Gold Card students are always admitted. Attendance is taken in the library, so students must arrive before the bell. During periods 1, 2, 3, 7 and 8 students not assigned to the Mustang Corral will need a pass from a librarian. Math Math Resource	Students using the Math Resource are expected to be on time and have their Student ID to scan for attendance. Students are to be seated at a table/computer, work on mathematics for the period, and be prepared to ask for help. During periods 1,2,3,7, and 8 students not assigned to Mustang Corral will need to bring a pass from their math teacher.	D374	<u>Monday – Friday</u> 7:15 – 3:20
Social Studies Social Studies Resource	A Social Studies teacher will be available to help with homework questions and essay writing. Students may also view videotapes that they missed, watch the news or access the Internet for class projects. During periods 1, 2, 3, 7 and 8 students not assigned to the Mustang Corral will need a pass from their social studies teacher.	A203	Periods 1, 2, 3, 7 & 8
World Language Language Technology – (A201) World Language Resource Center (A202)	The Language Technology Lab is open from 7:20-7:55 am and from 3:25-4:15 pm for students who want to drop in . During the rest of the day students must be with a class. Students are to work on specific assignments that involve the use of content area related technology. The Resource Center is open for tutoring and content area related computer work during lunch periods only. Students must arrive on time and have their ID's with them.
