- Fever of 100.4°F or higher
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 Nausea or vomiting
- Chills
- Fatique
- Muscle or body ache
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell

- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Diarrhea
- Have you been in close contact (6 feet or less for more than 15 minutes) with somebody who has recently tested positive for COVID-19 by nasal swab in the last 10 days?

If YES to any of the above - do not report to school. Call your school (North High at 630-795-8450 or South High at 630-795-8550) to report your absence. Call your medical provider for evaluation, treatment and information about when you can return to school.

- Parents/guardians are REQUIRED to initial and date and students are REQUIRED to present this slip to attend school (before boarding the school bus and before entering the school building).
- This slip certifies to us that students are free of symptoms and may report to school for In-Person Learning.

Anyone testing positive for COVID-19 must guarantine for 10 days and alert their health care provider. Students and staff members must be free of fever for at least 24 hours without fever-reducing medications, wait 10 days after symptoms started, ensure respiratory symptoms are improved by the end of 10 days.
